42/26 Residents Surgery

Weeds at the front of The Old School were reported. This is to be passed on to the Trustees of the building.

A resident had suggested an area of land on Wray Crescent, which is to be auctioned later this month, should be purchased to provide allotment land. Councillors felt the cost of purchase would far exceed the Council's resources however, the Ministry of Justice could be asked to investigate the possibility of providing a piece of land in the future.

The damaged tree on the Wymott Park Play Area has been dealt with by Chorley Council however, the swings have yet to be replaced.

41/26 Annual Governance and Accountability Return

42/26 Third Prison

Items for to be raised at the next Stakeholder meeting were discussed. It was noted information and consultations were not delivered to properties at the North of Ulmes Walton Lane, which will also be seriously affected. The speed limit along Ulmes Walton Lane should be reduced to 30mph via Lancashire County Council putting a Traffic Regulation Order in place and a mini roundabout at the junction of with Moss Lane would help with traffic flow and reduce speed. Care also needs to be taken that lighting of the construction areas, car parks etc is not directed towards any residential properties.
